Dear Students and Families,

The shelves await you with many new books to borrow, read and enjoy. I hope as I am that you are all looking forward to another exciting and rewarding time in the library.

I would love volunteers, please contact me if you would like to volunteer re-shelving books, help during class visits with book selections (very useful in grades K-1) and or general clean-up! (Current TB test must be on file in the office to volunteer.)

Library hours are 9:00-1:30 Monday-Thursday. Class visits and book borrowing will begin on Monday September 28th. Parents your child comes to the library weekly with their class, all children who have returned a signed permission slip may check out books. Grades K-2 may check out (1) book, and grades 3-6 may check out (2) books. All books need to come back to the library weekly. New this year, though it has been a district policy, grades K-1 will be leaving their borrowed books in the classroom, this will insure them a book to read and share in class.

Just a reminder, if your child has lost or damaged a book it must be replaced or pay for a new one before they may borrow another book. Working together we can foster a love of reading, how to respect and care for the books, and to return them on time.

Please check school's website; click "Library" there you will find our "wish list" (amazon.com) we are still far below the states average of 18-1 books per students, the complete library catalog of books (OPAC), reading lists and "Book Bug" information and forms. Donations, new or gently used hardcover books (age/grade appropriate), bookmarks and small toys for the "book bug" toy chest are always welcomed and appreciated.
